• Ash-Rand Rescue provided critical emergency services for 2000 people.

• 1637 second graders in CARE classes across Randolph county learned how to recognize and report sexual abuse.

• 130 low-income victims of domestic violence received free education, advice, and legal representation from Legal Aid.

• MERCE clinic provided A1c or prenatal lab screenings to 438 uninsured or underserved patients.

• In-home care from RCS enabled 112 Seniors to live independently in their own homes.

• YMCA scholarships helped 495 people work on improving their health through fitness activities and classes.
